

Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) II Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA): Student Portion

HEERF II CRRSAA Total: \$75,972

Purpose:

To provide emergency financial aid grants to students, "which may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care."¹

Elim Bible Institute and College HEERF II CRRSAA Eligibility Criteria:

Disbursement 1:

- Enrolled for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Pell recipient

Students who meet the above eligibility criteria will receive a \$500 HEERF II CRRSAA emergency grant.

Disbursement 2:

- Enrolled as a **full-time, residential** student for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Enrolled in an **undergraduate program**
 - Exception: *Applied Ministry Certificate (AMC)* students may also be considered for eligibility, as this program transfers directly into EBIC's BS in Theology Studies.
- U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Submit a 2020-2021 FAFSA
 - Meet SAP standards
- Exceptional financial need prioritized based on reported 2020-2021 Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)

Students who meet the above eligibility criteria will receive a one-time HEERF II CRRSAA emergency grant in the following amounts.

- EFC \$0-\$1,000: **\$950**
- EFC \$1,001 - \$6,000: **\$850**
- EFC \$6,001 - \$15,000: **\$770**
- EFC \$15,001 - \$30,000: **\$626**
- EFC \$30,001 and above: **\$532**

All funds will be disbursed via check in the mail on or before August 24, 2021. Students may use their HEERF II CRRSAA funds towards any EBIC outstanding balance as long as they provide written or electronic consent by August 23, 2021.
