Worship Emphasis Week

Growing a deeper relationship with the Lord one step at a time.

The importance of true worship has always been an indispensable mainstay of the Kingdom of God. The first of the 10 Commandments focuses on it, and Jesus clearly teaches us to “worship the Lord your God and serve Him only.” Worship has also been a cornerstone for Elim Bible Institute & College for nearly 100 years, and in light of that we recently designated a week of chapels to teach and emphasize its importance.

Dick Grout, EBIC’s Worship Director, kicked off our 2023 ‘Worship Emphasis Week’ by speaking on ‘Revival in Our Worship.’ Responding to the recent visitation of God in Asbury, Dick emphasized the need to first ‘Repent.’ Echoing Jonathan Edwards conviction that the primary characteristic, marking a work of the Holy Spirit, is that Jesus Christ is exalted, Dick encouraged us to take a hard look at who we are singing to, and the theological content of our worship songs.

Another important step to reviving our worship is ‘Revelation’. The Father sent His Holy Spirit to open our eyes and reveal Jesus to us, for only when He does can we truly worship Him! Finally, it’s imperative that we ‘Return.’ In the Matthew 17 account, Peter wanted to stay in that wonderful place of the presence of God. But, as Jesus did then, He continues to lead His disciples back down to the valley, where the world so desperately needs what we have received on the mountain top.

On Wednesday we had a totally different experience - a full hour of spontaneous worship! Prompted simply by a projected list of names and attributes of God, the only ‘songs’ sung that morning were composed by believers “singing and making melody in their heart

to the Lord.” The sounds of dancing and rejoicing were offset by the stillness of adoration and weeping. Pastor and EBIC Instructor Tim Case brought a powerful word Thursday morning on ‘Being a Worshiper.’ The form of worship is not the real issue, he said, for true worship is directly connected to the heart. Obedience to God is the greatest act of devotion that we can give, and “Not my will but Yours be done” are the words of a true worshiper.

Tim also taught us that servants and worshipers always go together (Matthew 4:10). You can’t be a worshiper of God without being His servant, for you will always serve what you worship, and worship what you serve. In closing, Tim said that if you want to worship, offer your life to God, and then carry your obedience into your times of musical worship. Gabe Cepeda, Worship and Tech Coordinator and Campus Life Director, brought the week to a close with a teaching on ‘Spiritual Maturity.’ He confirmed that times in corporate worship are glorious, but at some point we need to go back to our daily lives and do the other things the Lord has called us to do. A sign of spiritual maturity, Gabe said, is to worship like Job did when he lost everything and was still able to say, “The Lord gives, and the Lord takes away, blessed be the name of the Lord.”

A hallmark of the week was the fervency of devotion and sincerity expressed by the students as they were provided opportunity to spend time, concentrating on their loving Savior and Friend.

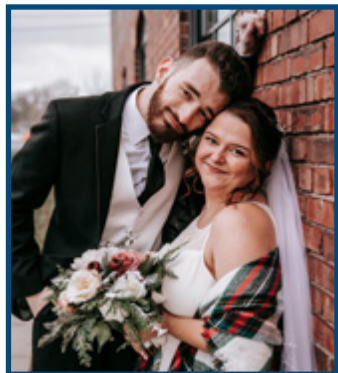

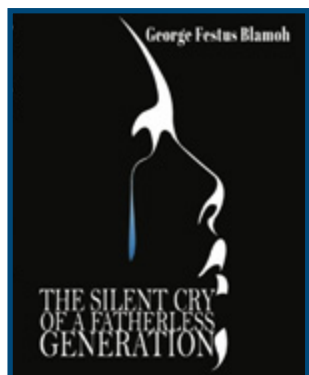

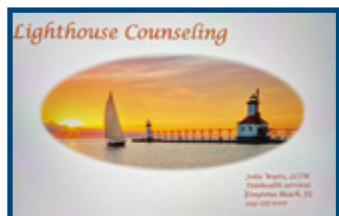
