

# **Dining Hall Updates**

Our cafeteria has gone through several new renovations!

EBIC is blessed to have a fully equipped kitchen and dining hall on campus. Our in-house kitchen crew prepares food for students and staff on a daily basis. The dining space is also used for special events and meetings. However, many aspects of the dining hall were becoming very outdated. EBIC leadership recognized the need and started addressing the outdated dining hall at the end of 2023.

During the Christmas break, the EBIC's Facilities team rented a carpet remover and took the old carpet out of the dining hall. A flooring contractor was hired to come right after Christmas and install new vinyl flooring. The hard-surface vinyl is easier to clean and is better suited for a dining hall. In addition to the new floor, 300 new black banquet chairs were purchased. These chairs have metal frames and vinyl upholstery making them easy to clean and they look sharp!

The new floor and chairs made a big difference in the dining hall, but other parts of the room were still worn and outdated. One of our adjunct teachers, Kelly Walsh, came forward with a proposal for additional remodel work. With our leadership's blessing, preparations were made, and Kelly and her team went to work during the week of the winter break in February. Kelly oversaw the project and worked primarily with a great team of EBIC staff and students.

The old chair rail trim was removed from the dining hall and decorative battens were added to the lower half of the walls. The dining hall was painted grey and white, and the wall lighting was updated with new fixtures. The serving stations were painted black, and the wooden windowsills were sanded and refinished. The team worked hard, and the end result was beautiful!

As I write this, there is another update scheduled. During the upcoming Easter Break, we will be redoing the concrete epoxy floor in the dining hall serving area. The new epoxy on this floor will help to tie all the updates together and give the entire dining hall a fresh look!

We are grateful for Kelly and all who worked hard to complete these tasks. We are also thankful for the donors whose generosity helped make this project possible.

# Worship Emphasis Week

A lifestyle that honors King Jesus!

For 100 years EBIC has purposely trained Christ-centered Spirit-empowered servant leaders for global ministry and worldwide revival. Our goal is to inspire past and future generations to grow in their relationship with God and be rooted in a deeper biblical foundation. One of these biblical foundations is worship.

The growth of contemporary worship music in the church has not only brought a variety of musical styles, but a misconstrued idea of what true biblical worship is. Thus, EBIC sought the importance of creating a special week where its chapel services would be designated to deeply study what the Bible says regarding worship. This year, our Worship Emphasis Week took place on our campus from Tuesday, March 5th to Friday, March 8th. The theme for the week was, "Worship goes beyond music; it is a lifestyle that honors the King!"

Rev. Barry Kwallek started our week by emphasizing the fact that every moment is an opportunity to worship God. He stated that worship is a fundamental purpose of human existence, extending beyond traditional expressions like singing in church. Rev. Kwallek challenged our students to worship God in various aspects of their lives, including work, school, and personal time. He stressed the diverse ways individuals can worship the Lord; urging our students to, most importantly, develop a deeper relationship with the Lord.

On Wednesday, Brother Samuel Case touched on the condition of our hearts. Based on the story of Cain and Abel, he stated that the issue wasn't the type of offering Cain presented but the condition of his heart. He encouraged the students to examine their hearts before the Lord and ask Him to show them if there was anything that may be hindering their worship

of God. Similarly to Rev. Kwallek, Brother Sam concluded his message by encouraging the students to focus on strengthening their relationship with God as true worship stems from genuine love and adoration for Him.

Oftentimes in our Christianity, we tend to forget that every blessing received comes from the Lord. This is why David commanded his soul to praise God and told himself to not forget the goodness of the Lord. In Psalm 103:1-2 he states, "Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits." We need to be careful not to exchange our worship and thanksgiving for complacency and complaint. This is why on Thursday, Brother Kirk Adams, using Psalm 136, reminded the students to give thanks to the Lord as His goodness and mercy endures forever. Even though Christians experience struggles, difficulties, and hardships, Kirk reminded us that our hope lies in Jesus, who succeeded in the wilderness on our behalf.

I had the privilege to close our Emphasis Week on Friday night, encouraging our students to keep an attitude of praise, and reminding them that God loves and cares for them unconditionally. In my message, I addressed the issue of pride, distinguishing between a healthy sense of satisfaction for a job well done and the sinful pride that exalts oneself above others and even God. I urged the students to be watchful of the dangers of laziness, cautioning against procrastination and a lack of diligence in both the physical and spiritual realms. Lastly, I reminded our students against confusing busyness with true spiritual engagement, emphasizing the need for intentional rest and quality time spent with God.

# Week of Prayer
