Policy Statement:

Violations of the Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action or possible suspension.

Procedure:

A student may receive a suspension from EBIC after the following procedural steps:

1. Receive a written warning specifying the nature of the issue and the conditions of continual enrollment.
2. If the violation is repeated, the students will be asked to attend an “Administration Hearing” held by the College’s Administrative Committee. The student’s behavior and written warning will be reviewed with the student present at this meeting. The student will be given an opportunity to address the committee and provide additional information.
3. The Administrative Committee will make the decision. Since the President is a part of the Admin Committee, its decision is final.
4. A designated Admin Committee member will give the students a written letter, which will communicate the Committee’s decision.

Please note: A violation of the college’s Statement of Faith may result in an immediate suspension without prior written warning or “Admin Hearing”.
